Subject - Setting up of CSCs in every Panchayat/ village of Uttar Pradesh

Dear

The Common Service Centre (CSC) Scheme approved by the Government of India in September 2006, is being implemented by Department of Electronics & Information Technology (DeitY, GOI) under the National e-Governance Scheme (NeGP) for establishing CSCs across the Country. The CSCs are to deliver various Government to Citizen (G2C) and Business to Citizen (B2C) services across the Country.

2. The CSC e-Governance Services India Limited (CSC SPV) is a Company formed under the Companies Act 1956, Secretary of DeitY being the Chairman of the organization to enable delivery of various services at the Central and the State level and also enabling setting up of CSCs Pan India.

3. Empowered Committee on CSC Scheme in its meeting held on 06.07.2012 has considered integrating various rural and urban CSC like kiosks established under other programs with the CSC network established in States/ UTs. All such kiosks which are proposed to be integrated, mandatorily need to have the minimum infrastructure as prescribed for CSCs and will need to be registered on the CSC Portal and OMT.

4. DeitY, GOI has issued a letter vide letter No. 2(76)/2006 - EGPMU (Vol III) dated 27.01.2015 stating that States should involve DeGS (District e-Governance Society) for supervising, monitoring and implementation of the CSC Scheme. DeGS to identify and select VLEs in Panchayats and provide all required support. In view of the above, NIC - UP is requested to use their good offices through DIOs in the State in establishing the CSC network, at least 1 (one) in every Panchayat/ Village to deliver various citizen centric service.
